

Fluorescent Lighting Fixture Replacement Project

The Pulaski County Sole Commissioner is seeking bids from licensed Electricians for fluorescent lighting fixture replacement in the Pulaski County Government Services building at 45 S. Lumpkin St., Hawkinsville, Ga.

Bid dollar amount for installation of each individual fixture.

To be considered, bids must be received by 10:00 a.m. on August 6, 2010, at the Pulaski County Commissioner's Office, Attn: Mr. Brooks Bailey, P. O. Box 29, 45 S. Lumpkin St., Hawkinsville, Ga. 31036.

All bids must be sealed and should be clearly labeled. Any bids received after August 6, 2010, will not be considered.

Work Requirements:

Install approximately 100 2' x 4' troffer fixtures following standard electrical and safety standards. (minimum of at least 80 fixtures and no more than 120 fixtures)

The county will provide the fixtures and any additional wire needed.

Contractor will schedule with each individual office the date and time of installation with some offices requiring after hours installation.

Office desk and counter areas must be covered with cloth or plastic to protect these areas from dust and debris

Existing bulbs will be sorted according to condition prior to fixture removal and upon removal stored in manner described by county.

Existing fixtures will be stacked and stored on the premise by contractor in area designated by the county. (The county will separate the materials and deliver to recycling center. The county will retain all earnings provided by the recycler).

All work will be inspected and must be approved by the City/County Building Inspector.

All work must be completed and invoices for payment submitted by August 25th, 2010.

Successful bidder must:

- 1. be licensed electrician in State of Georgia**
- 2. provide proof of Worker's Compensation and General Liability insurance coverage.**
- 3. comply with Davis-Bacon requirements including submission of certified payroll weekly during course of project**
